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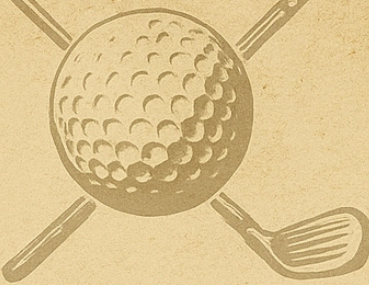
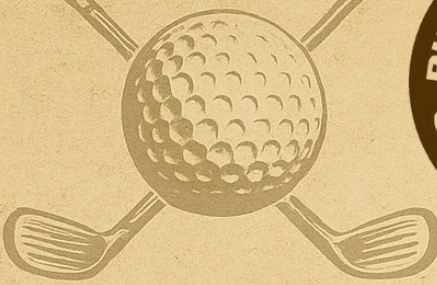

Pilots for Kids: Fall Golf Tournament

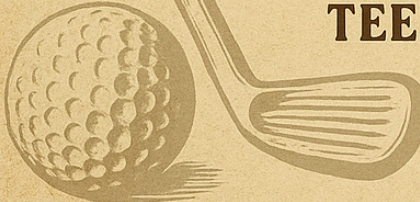
There is still time to sign up for the Pilots for Kids Golf Tournament on Friday, November 21st. To sign up, email pfkSavannah@gmail.com.
